

Aqualine Regatta 58 Specification



Aqualine's reputation for design and construction is second to none on the Inland Waterways of the UK. The new Regatta offers the popular reverse layout combined with simple and modern styling. The boat is constructed with Aqualine's usual high quality of materials and craftsmanship, with after-sales support provided by The New Boat Co. The boat comes complete with CE mark, full owner's manual with wiring diagrams and instructions, plus a full 12 month warranty and extended warranties on many parts. The standard craft is 58ft although other lengths up to 70ft long are possible, in order to incorporate more rooms or just more space in existing rooms.

Key features:

- Steelwork treated with a primer and a high gloss paint finish
- Hull built to CBA Code of Practice guidelines with a single full length rubbing strake the hull is blacked but this is not suitable for salt/brackish water
- High specification galley at the stern with hardwood edged worksurface
- Pump out electric macerator loo as standard
- Stirling combi unit 1500w inverter and 40amp charger
- Hand-painted roof and cabin sides (above gunwhale) with deep hardwood cappings
- The boat comes fully ballasted (Customer to install trim ballast as needed)

Engine - Isuzu 35 Diesel engine:

4 cylinder 1500cc engine with one 80 amp & one 80amp alternator. 4 cylinders keel cooled. Low noise Indirect Injection. PRM 120 mechanical gearbox. Standard control panel.

Paint Scheme:

We offer a range of designs and paint combinations (single colour paint and coachline as standard) of paint. All decks, roof and gunwhales are sanded to give a non-slip finish.operating location.

Lining and wood type:

Painted ply roof with hardwood cappings running longitudinally. Panelled cabin walls with painted insets and oak or ash faced veneered plywood under gunwhale.

Flooring:

Vinyl in galley and bathroom with carpet elsewhere.
(Vinyl throughout would be available at an extra cost).

Heating system:

Diesel fired central heating system with programmer, running low level concealed fin radiators through a twin coil 13 gallon calorifier. There is also a heated towel rail in the bathroom. This system is also connected to the engine cooling circuit meaning that the engine will heat the hot water.

240v power system:

These craft come with a 240v system as standard, tested and installed to the relevant RCD standards. This has 4 stainless double sockets (plus a plastic socket concealed inside the TV unit) and simply needs plugging into the shore power. All boats carry a Stirling 1500w Inverter with 40 amp charger as standard, and an upgrade to a 2100w Inverter is available.

12v System:

3 x 110 amp semi-traction Domestic batteries which are charged by a dedicated alternator. These are connected to a purpose-built distribution panel, and the system has fuses for all of the appliances. The lighting is halogen down lighters throughout the boat.

Galley:

Steps from the stern lead down to a Split galley, with a range of base units and shelves providing plenty of storage. The cupboard doors have inlaid banding to provide a design feature and the worksurface has a hardwood edge. The galley is well equipped with a full-sized stainless steel Stoves 500 hob and oven, a 4 cu ft fridge plus a deep full size stainless steel sink with mixer tap.

Saloon:

Large Saloon designed for free standing furniture with a solid fuel stove and TV cupboard with aerial socket. A dinette can be fitted at the galley end which also provides an extra berth.

Bathroom:

Vetus electric macerator toilet, vanity unit with hand basin set into a hardwood-edged worktop. There is a fully tiled, full-sized corner shower with a mixer unit. The shower is surrounded by a hardwood glazed screen and door. There is a heated towel rail, and further storage provided by a cupboard with shelves above.

Bedroom:

Fixed double with lockers under and overhead cupboard with down lights. At the end of the bed is full height wardrobe containing clothes rail with open shelving unit on opposing side. Steps lead up to the bow deck and the bow doors are hardwood, glazed, and fully lockable.
